



Harbor Club Members “Adopt a Hole”

Concept: Golfing Members volunteer to Adopt a Hole to do our part to helping maintain pristine conditions on that hole coordinating with Superintendent.

How are holes assigned? Family participation is encouraged, it would generate twice the attention to a hole. If you live on a hole, you can pick that hole or be assigned a hole. Hope is to have several families/members per hole.

Timing: November 1st.

Work expected: Work includes special attention on your hole to repair ball marks on greens and divots in fairways. (No planting of any vegetation). Work can be done while playing the hole, ex: if you play 3 times a week, you can focus on your hole and recruit your group to help. Keep in mind pace of play, you don't have to fill/repair all at one time. (Place rakes in bunkers.)

How to sign up? On MGA and LGA websites, there will be a sign-up sheet where you can check yes to volunteer and if you live on a hole, what hole that is. All other holes will be assigned randomly. **Sign-up to begin October 1st-15th.**

Divot days: MGA and LGA will coordinate with maintenance team for special divot days on Monday's once a quarter if possible. Maintenance team provides the sand.
