

MGA Lost Ball Tournament Rules Highlights

1. Each team will receive 1 Tournament Ball. Each team has opportunity to buy Tournament Ball Mulligan for \$15 (Limit 1 and must be purchased prior to round).
2. Each team member plays his own ball from tee through green. Two scores are recorded each hole, 1 tournament ball score, 1 score from other two players. All scores will be net score, dots should be on scorecard.
3. Team determines order of play for Tournament Ball and continues that rotation through 18 holes, ex: Player 1 starts tournament ball on hole 1 and plays the ball on 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, and 16. Player 2 plays Tournament ball on hole 2 and plays it on 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, and 17. Player 3 plays Tournament ball on hole 3 and plays it on 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, and 18. NO CHANGES
4. If Tournament ball is lost, and the team has THE MULLIGAN BALL, it can replace the lost Tournament ball with NO PENALTY, as a true mulligan. Subsequently, if the team loses The Tournament Ball and/or the Mulligan Ball on hole, record score on that hole with appropriate penalty strokes. On all following holes, a 1 stroke penalty is added to each hole played until completion of the round (even though all balls are lost, you must keep same rotation and recording 2 scores, 1 in tournament ball rotation and other best net score).

Scoring: Each team must return their Tournament Ball(s) at end of the round. The Tournament Ball net score will be recorded for each hole and the lowest net score from one of the other two players is recorded for the team's total hole score. Turn scores into the clubhouse upon completion.
